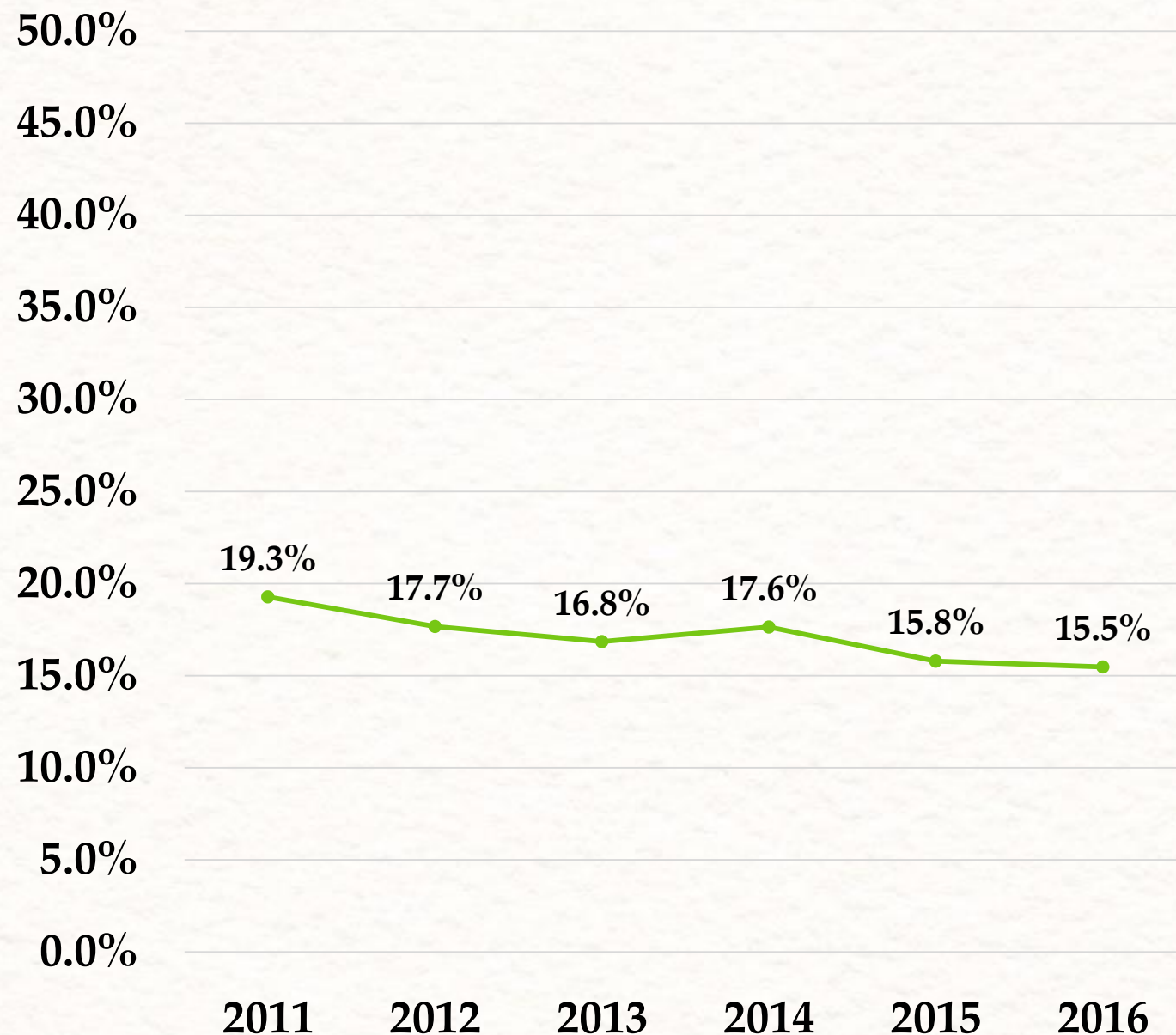
Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System

- Largest, on-going telephone survey in the world
- Adults ages 18+
- Collaboration between CDC and state
- Florida BRFSS conducted annually since 1986
- Collects data on individual risk behaviors and preventive health practices

Survey Methodology (Random Digit Dialing)

- Starting in 2011, cell phone samples were added to survey
 - 51.0% of Florida households are cell phone only based on modeled estimates (Sources: National Health Interview Survey, 2011-2015; U.S. Census Bureau, American Community Survey, 2010-2014; and infoUSA.com consumer database, 2011-2015)
- 2016 BRFSS: 55% Landline, 45% Cellphone
- 36,955 interviews were conducted for 2016 survey

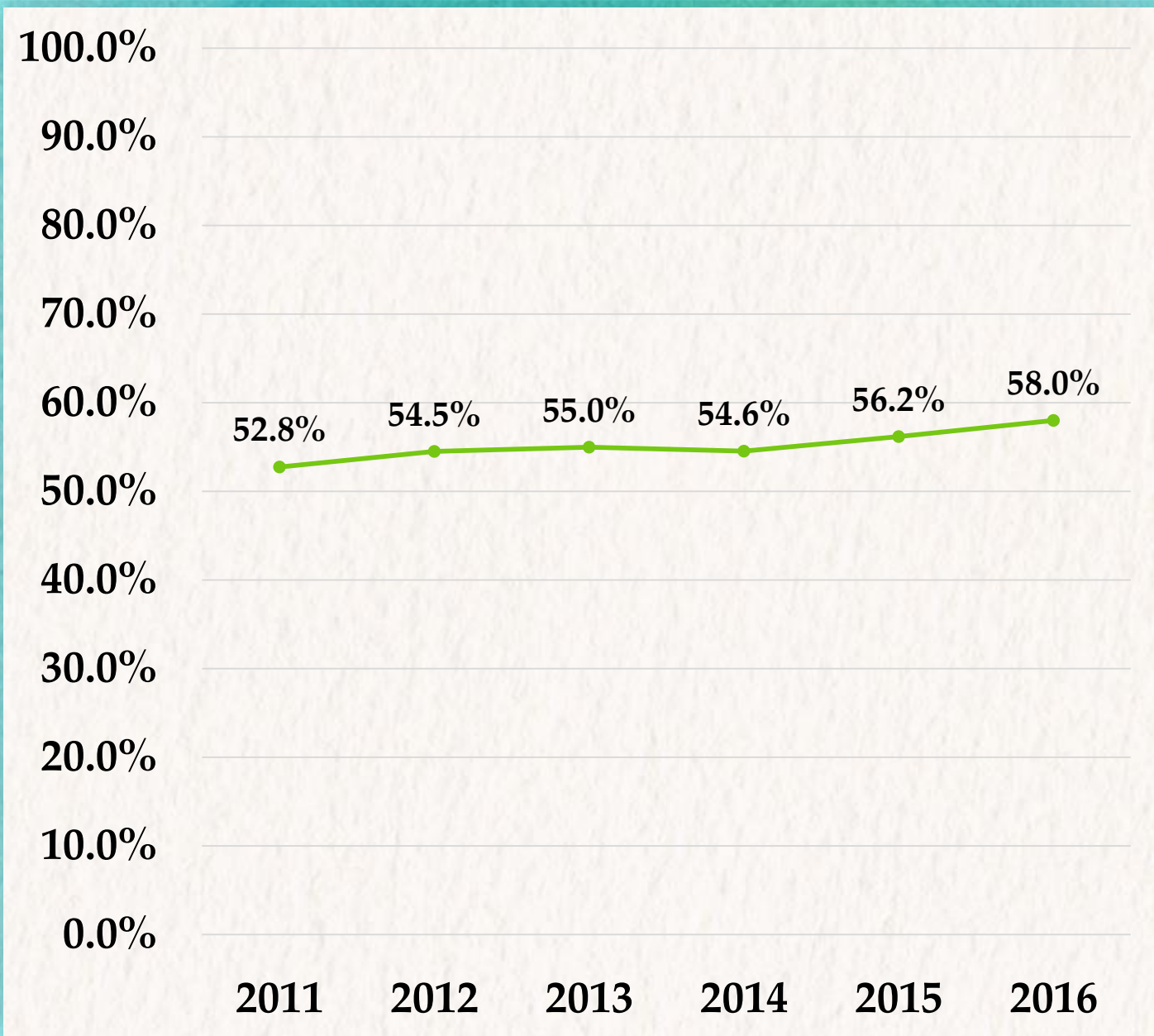
2011-2016 % of Adults Who Are Current Smokers

2011-2016 % of Adults Who Never Smoked



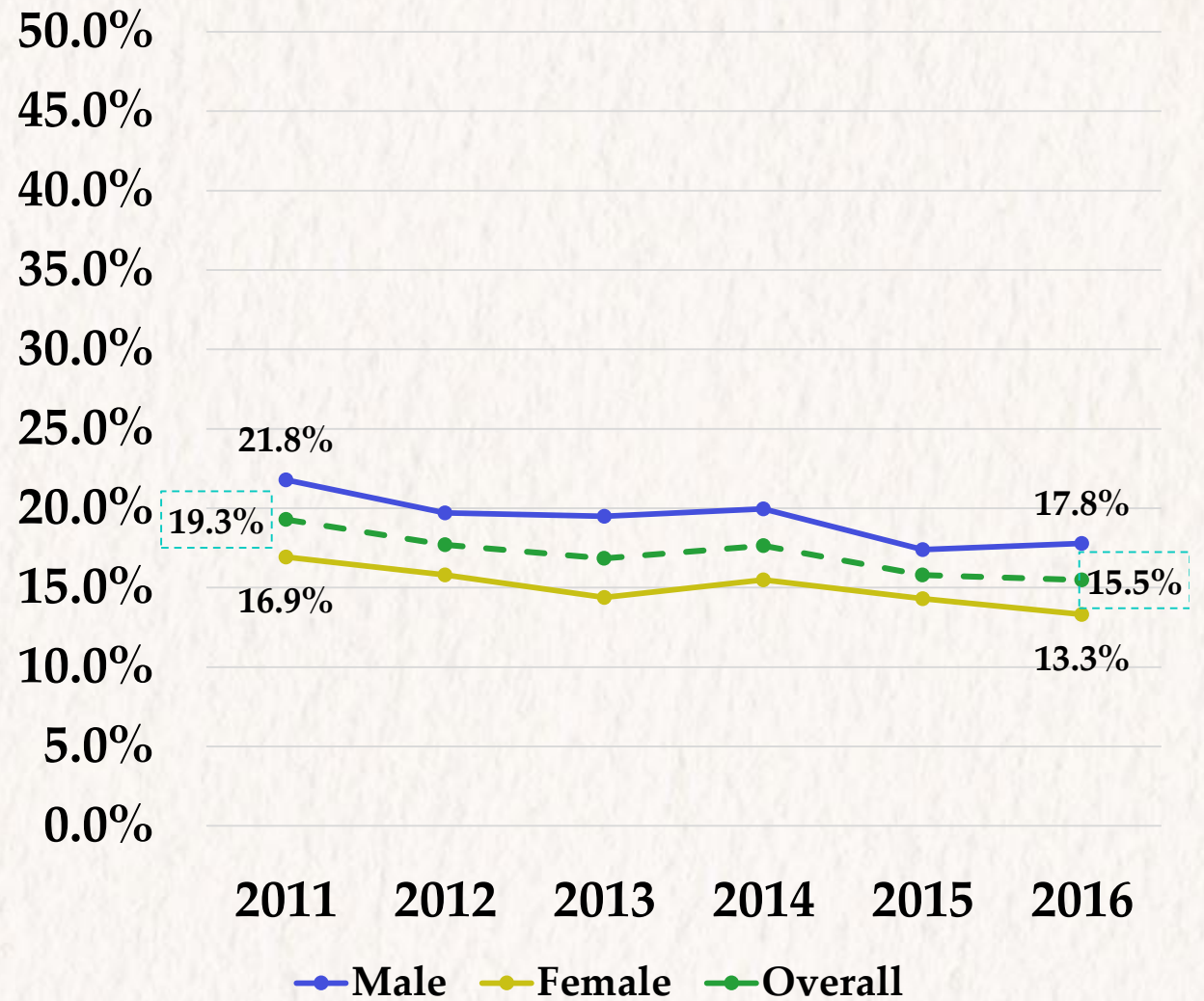
2011 - 2016 % of Adults Who Have Used Smokeless Tobacco



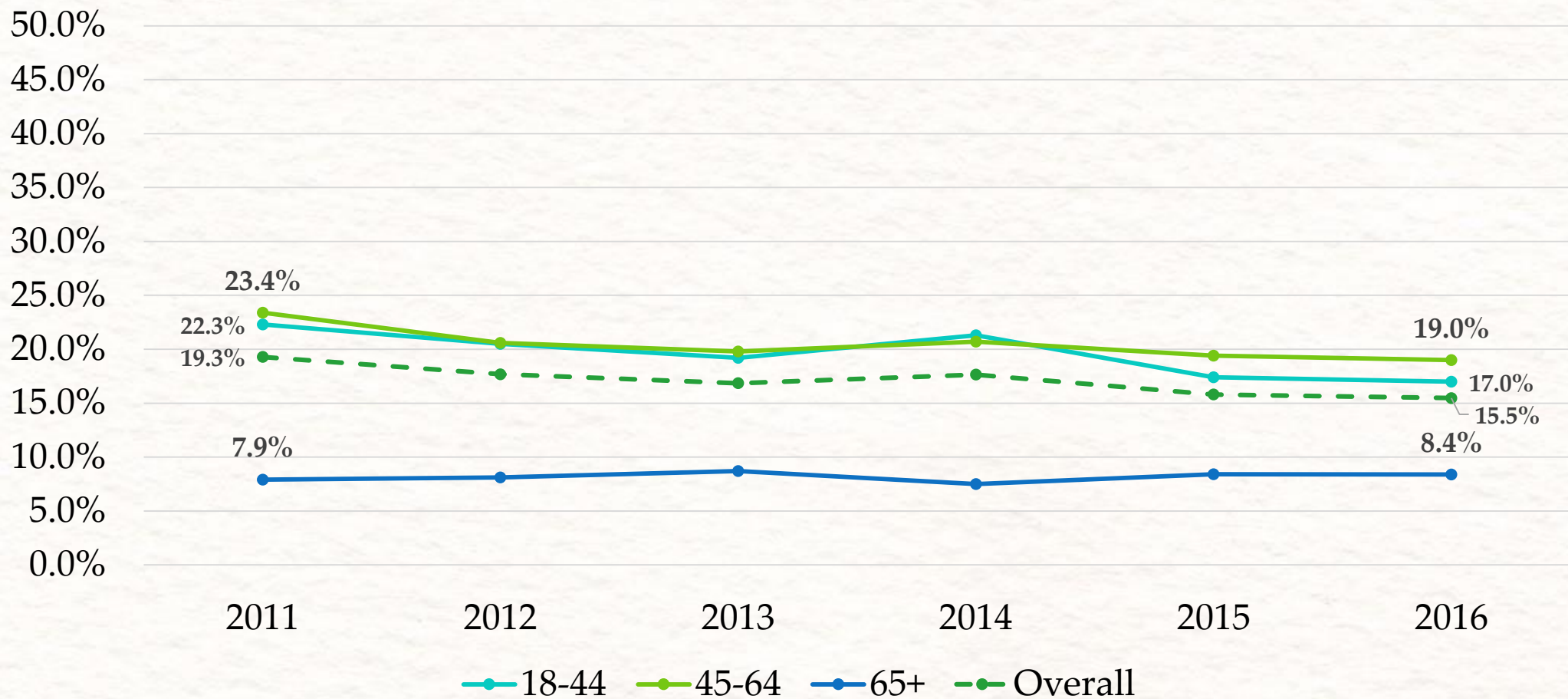
2011-2016 % of Current Smokers Who Tried to Quit in the Past Year



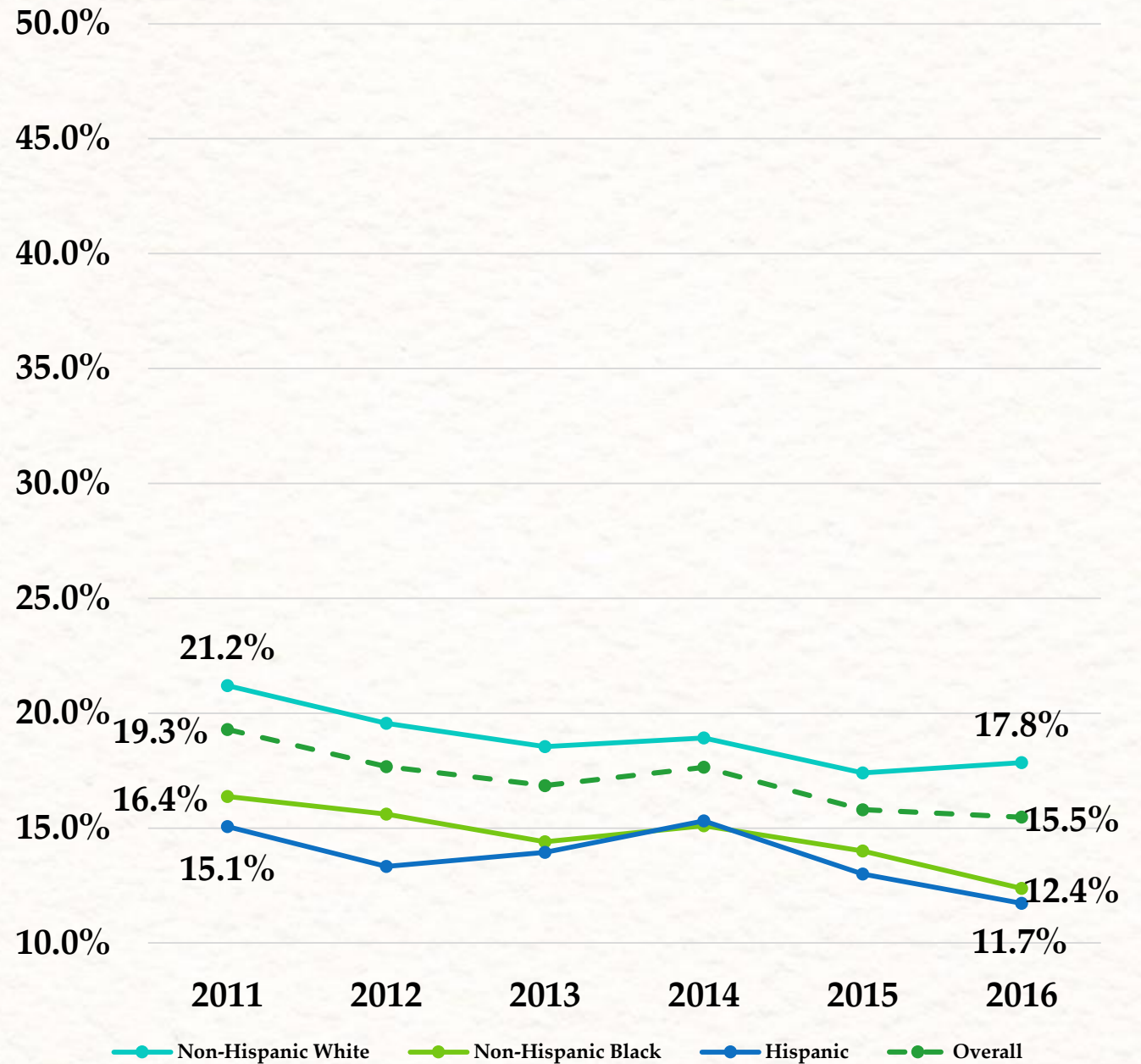
2011-2016 % of Current Smokers by Gender



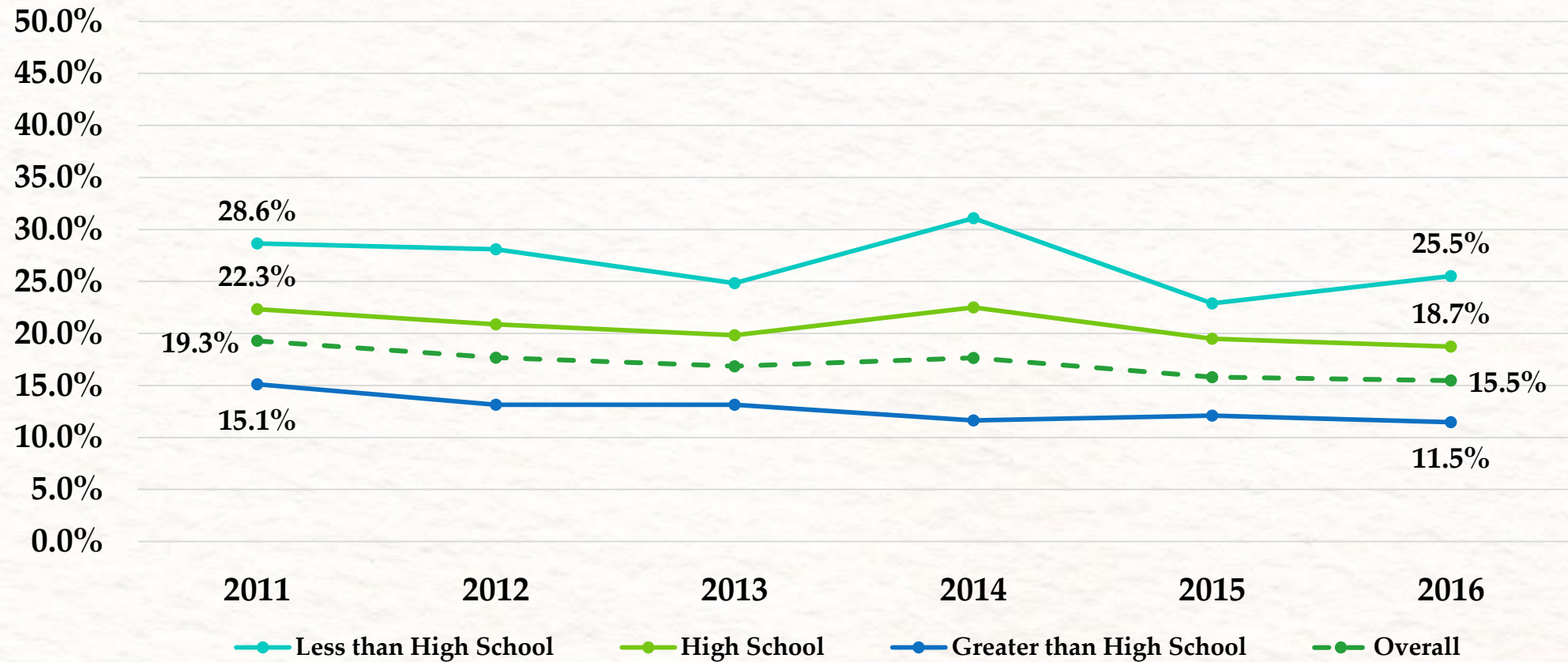
2011-2016 % Current Smokers by Age



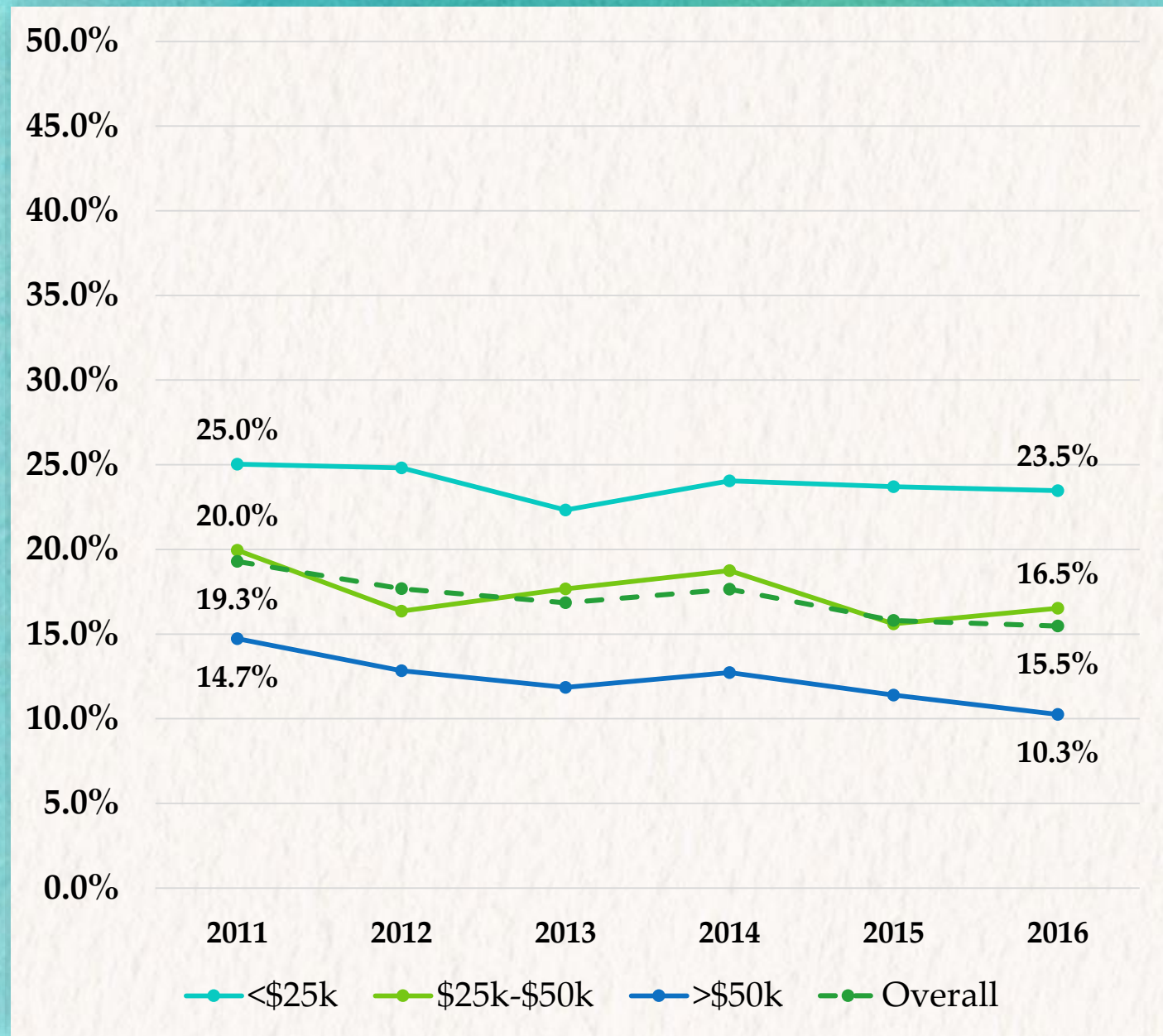
2011-2016 % of Adults Who Are Current Smokers by Race/Ethnicity



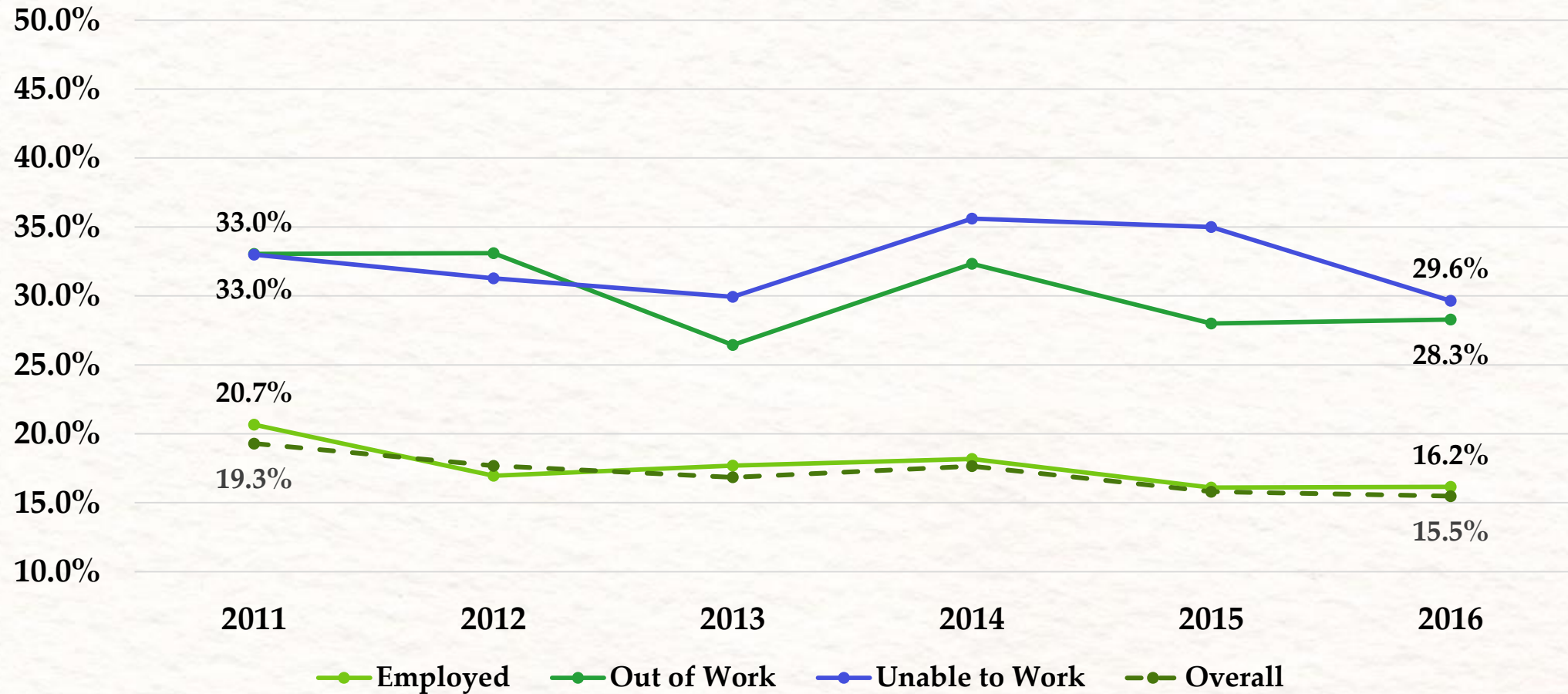
2011-2016 % of Current Smokers by Education



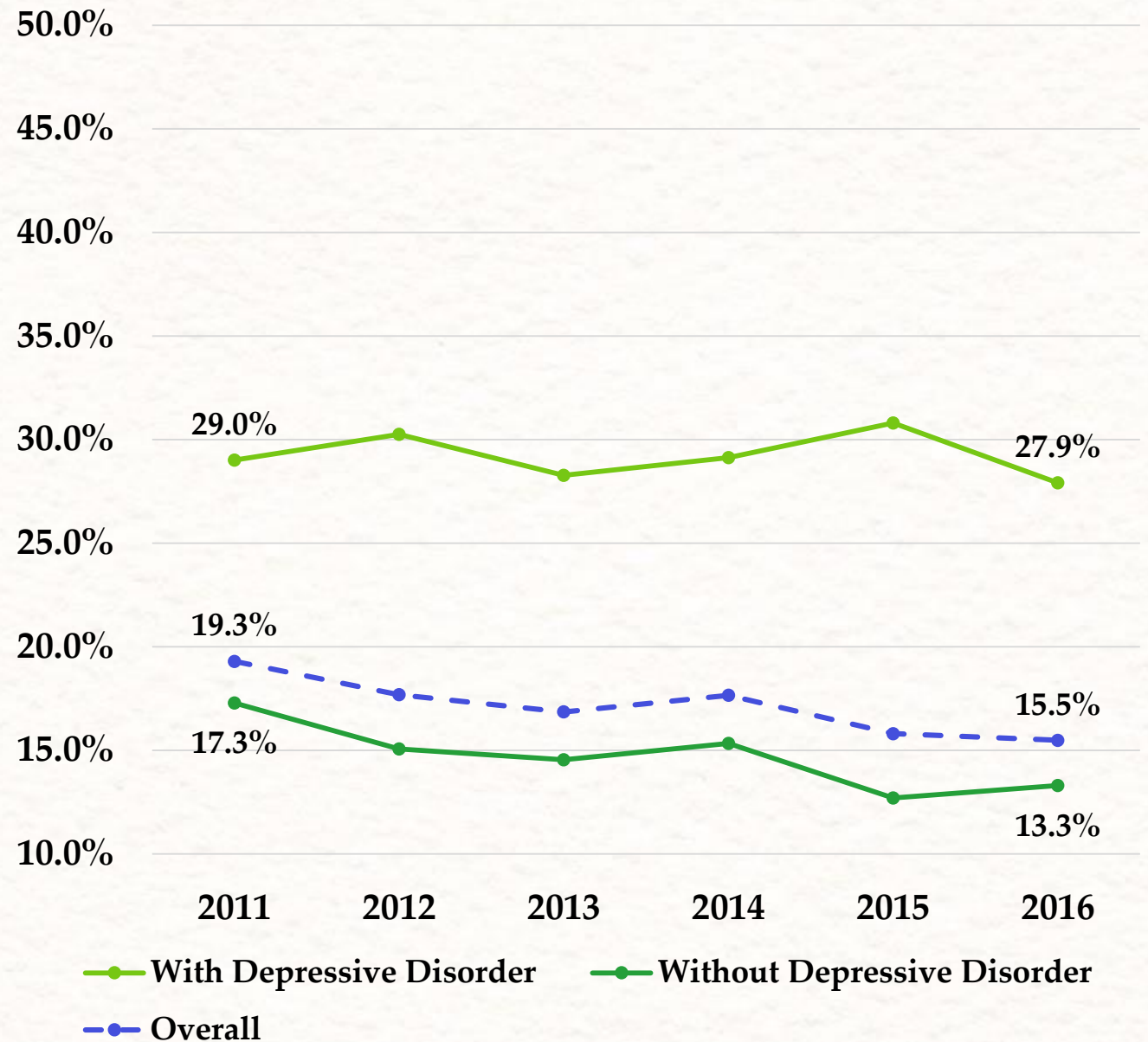
2011-2016 % of Current Smokers by Income



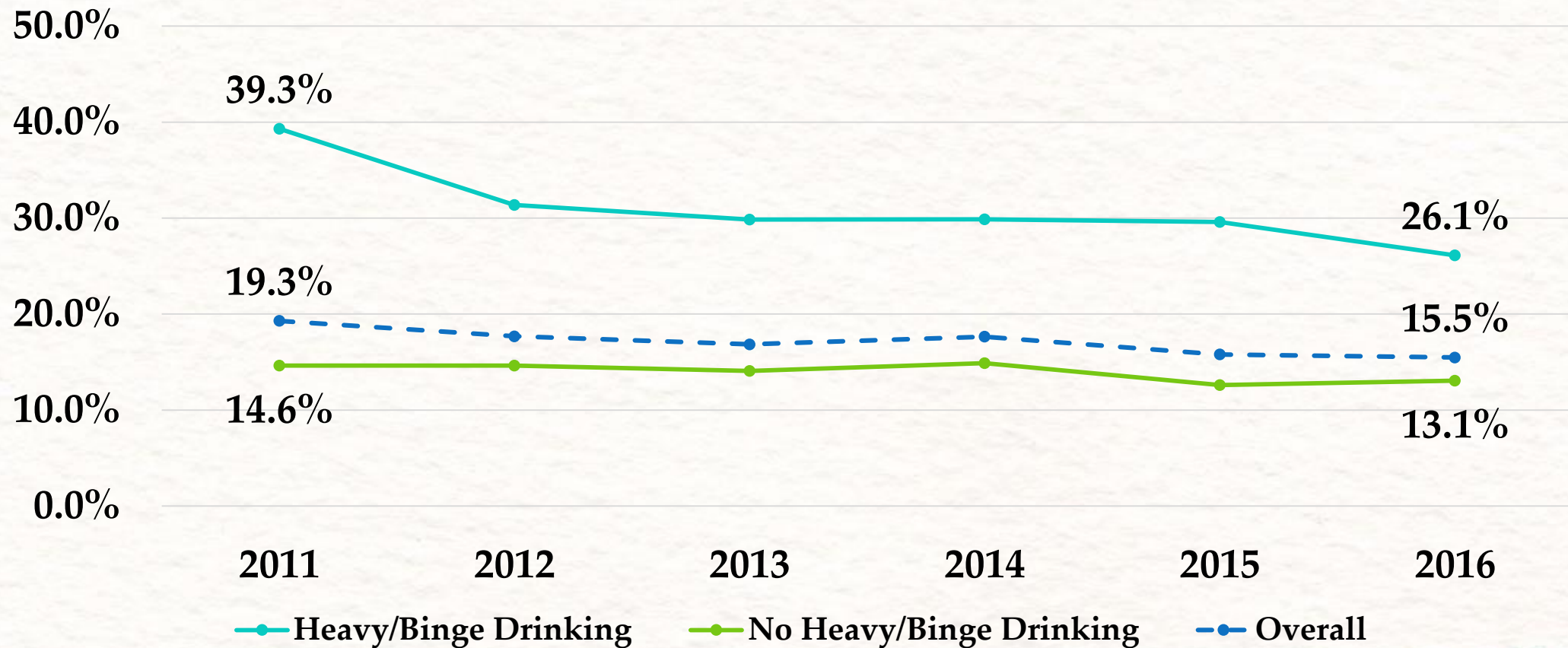
2011-2016 % of Current Smokers by Employment Status



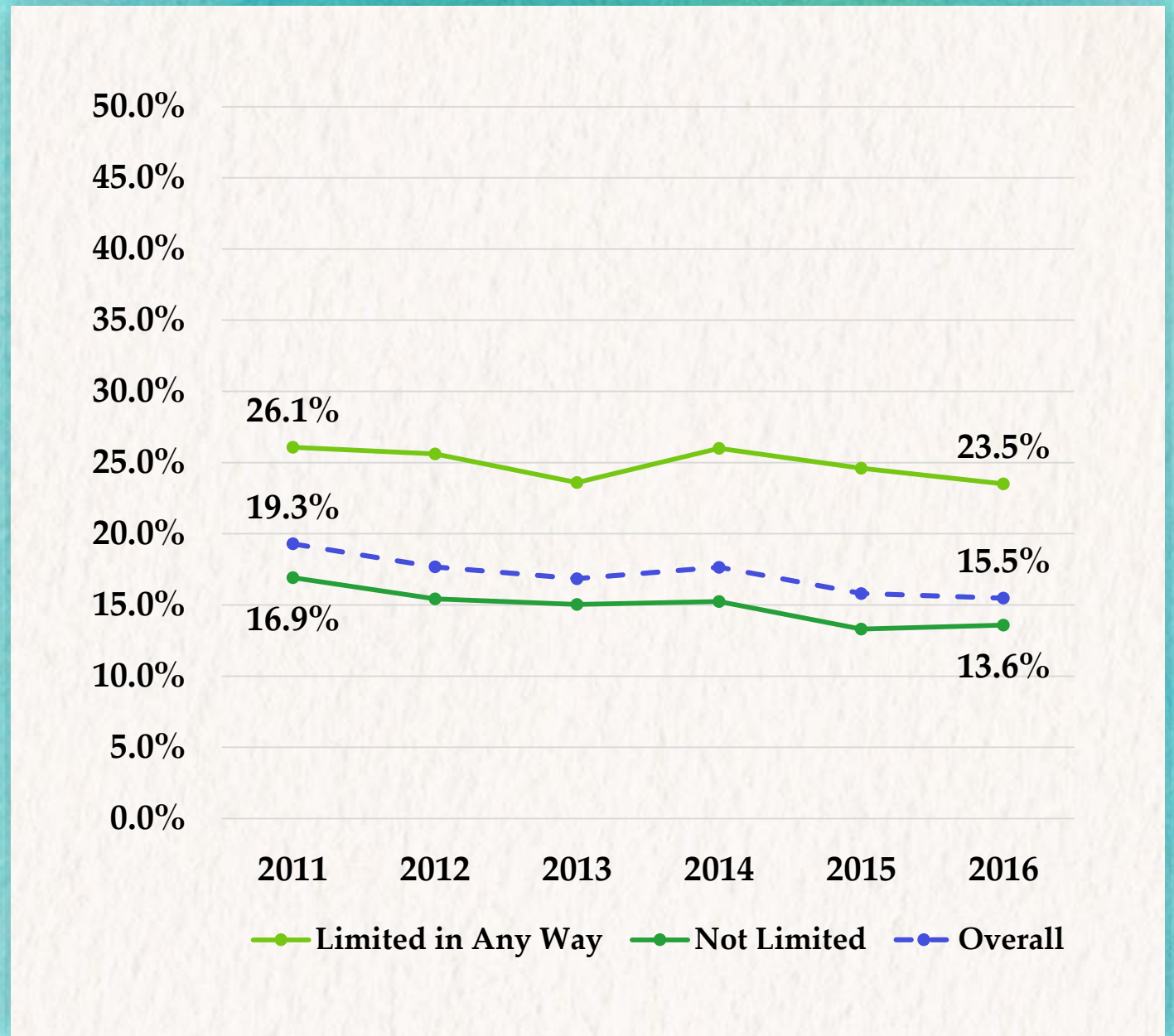
2011-2016 % of Current Smokers by Depressive Disorder Status

2011-2016 % of Current Smokers by Disability Status

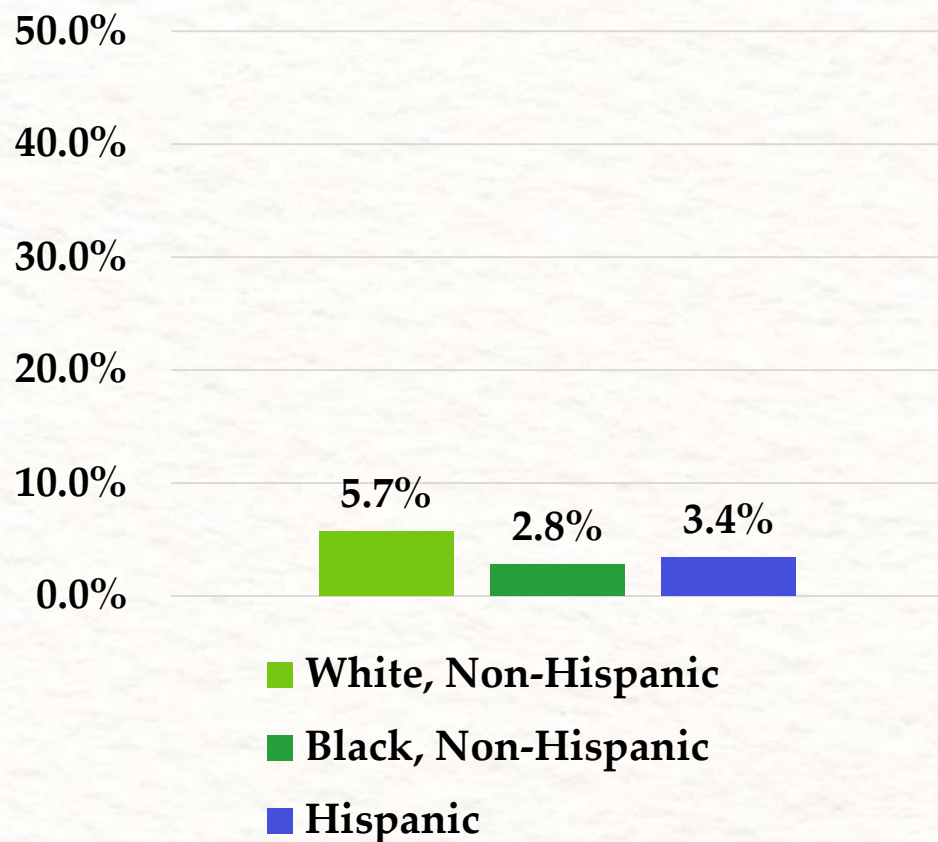


E-Cigarette Use

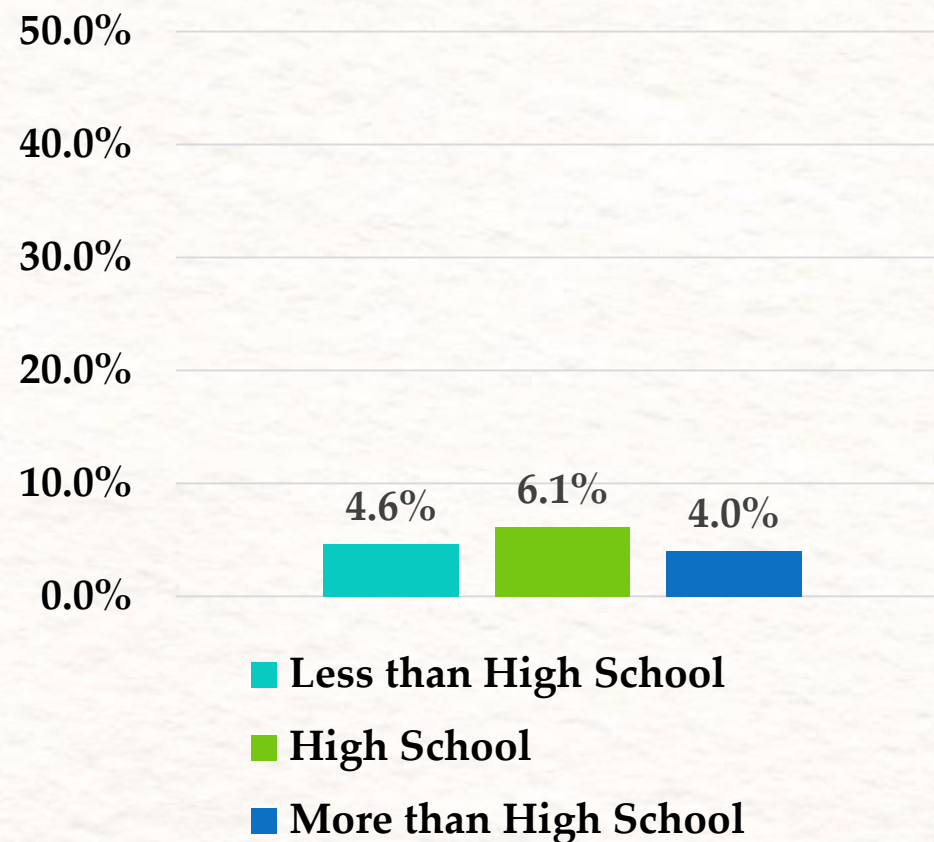
- In 2016, two questions on E-Cigarettes were added to the BRFSS core component as emerging core
- 20.3% of Floridians have used E-Cigarettes or other electronic vaping products at least once in their life
- 4.7% of Floridians currently use E-Cigarettes
 - 2014, 6.2% of adults used E-Cigarettes
 - 2015, 5.8% of adults used E-Cigarettes

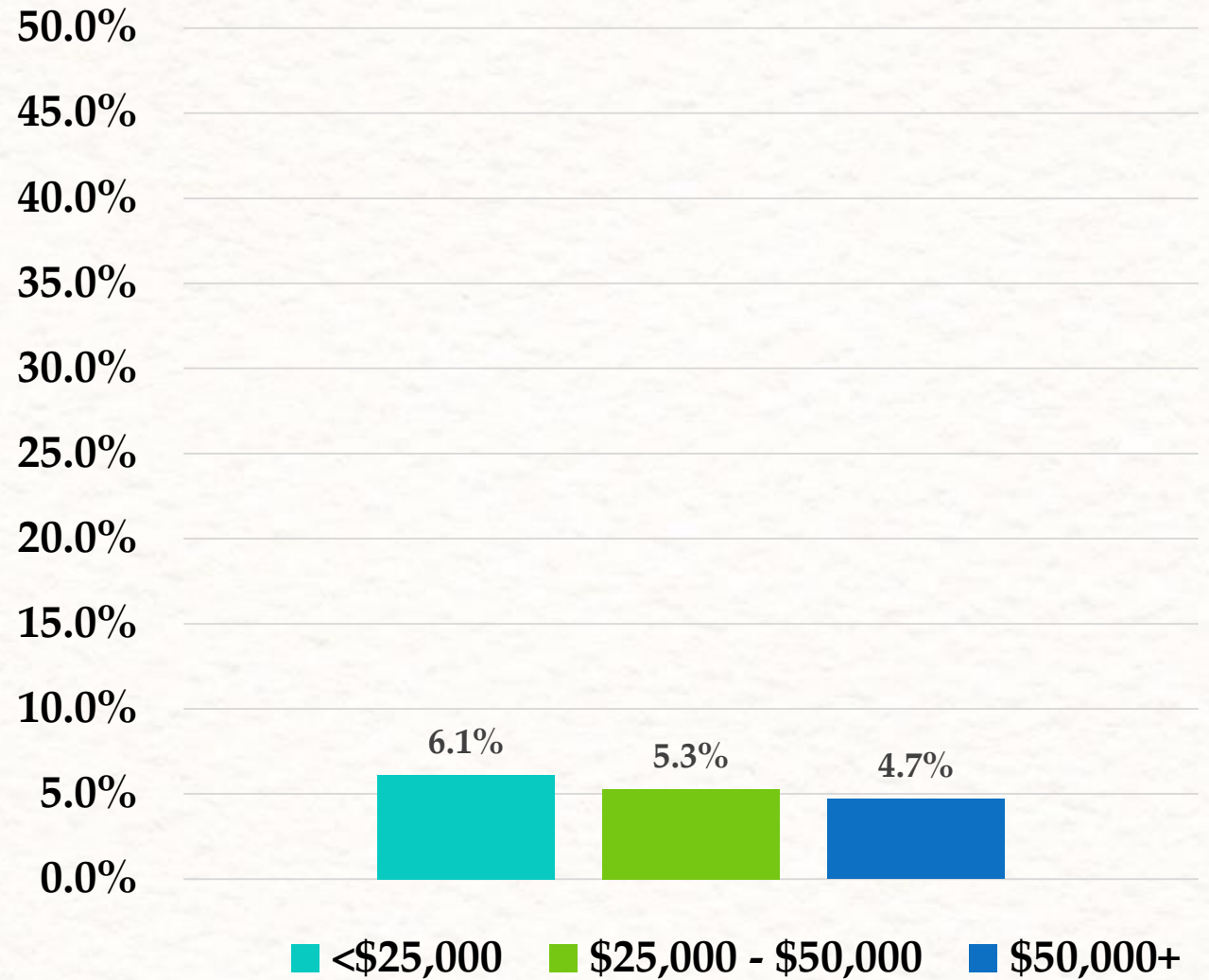

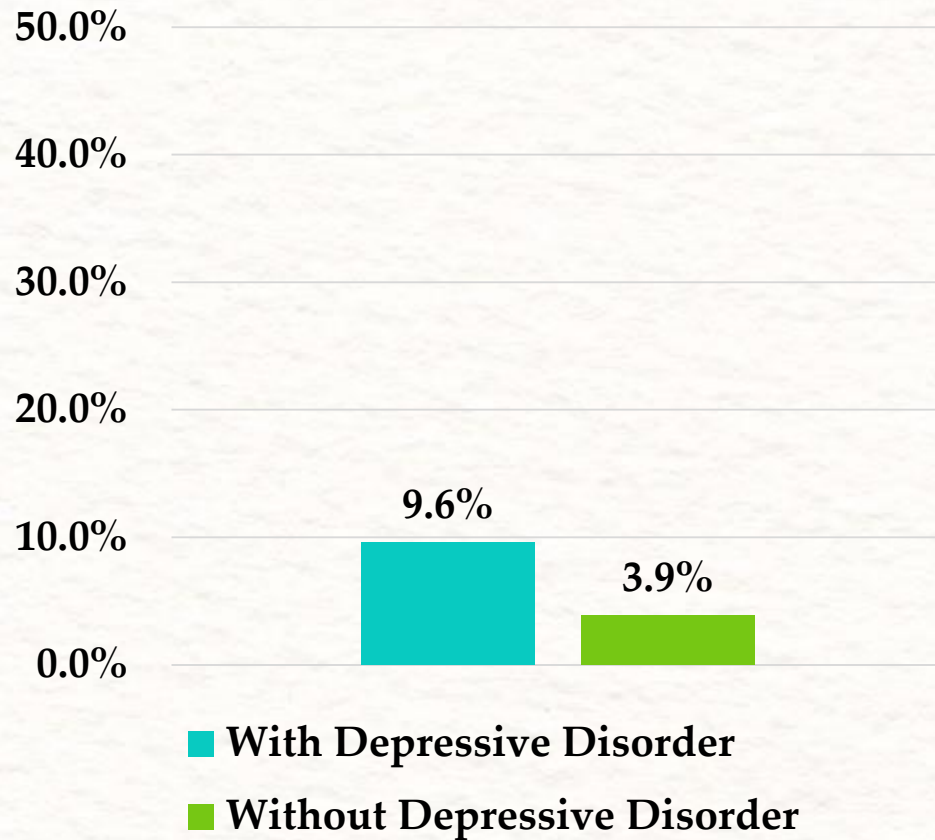


2016 Current E-Cigarette Users by Income

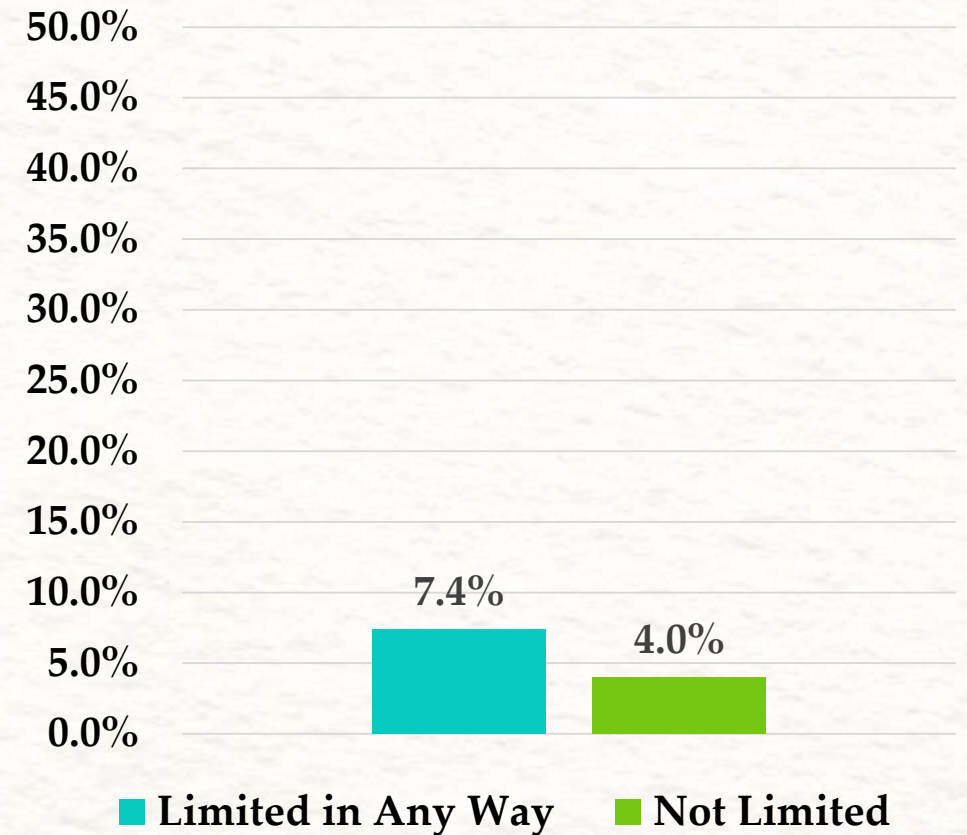

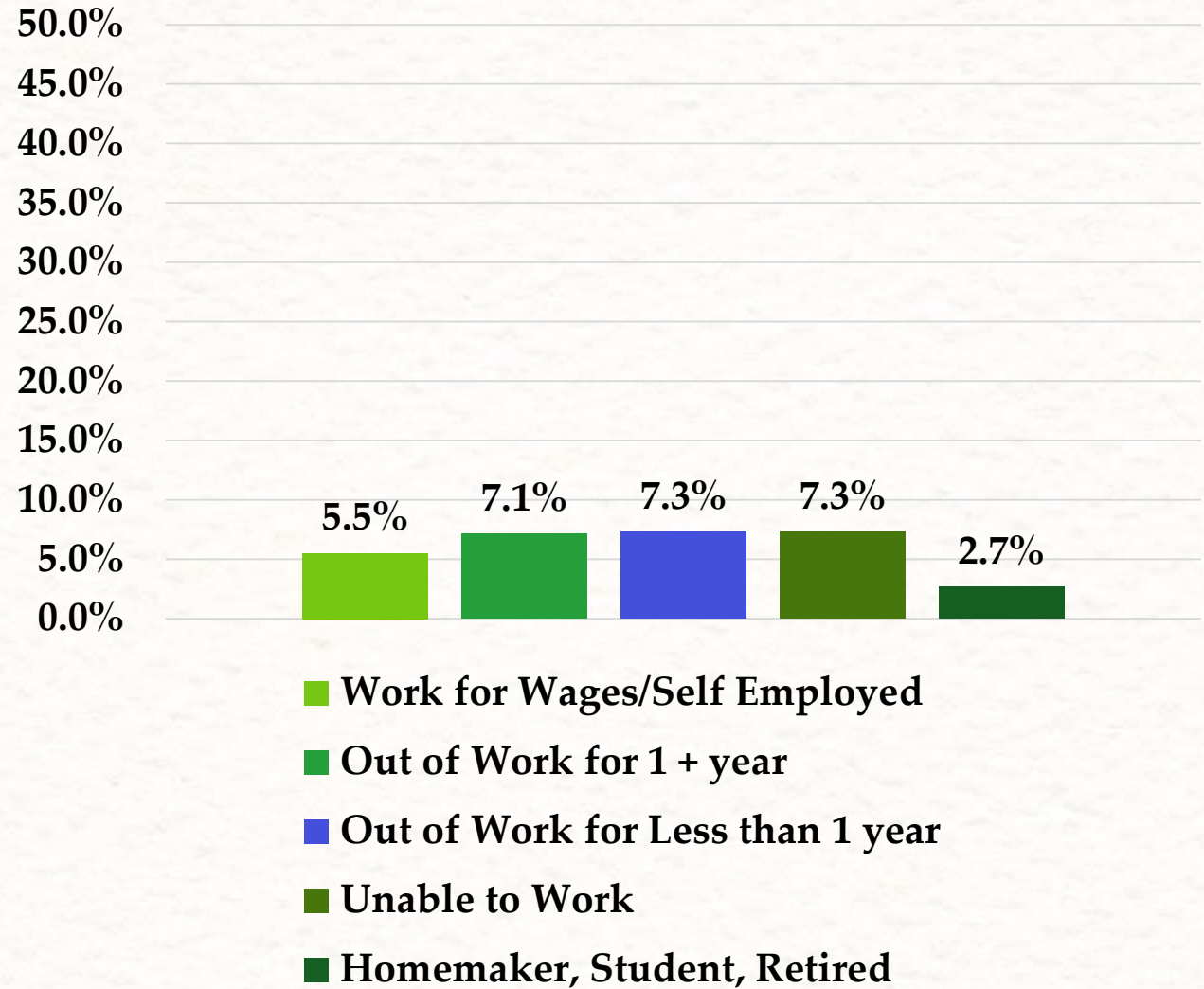
Depressive Disorder Status

Summary

- In Florida, there has been a 19.7% decrease in current smokers from 2011 to 2016
- People who are limited in any way by a disability are more likely to be current smokers or e-cigarette users
- People who suffer from depressive disorders are more likely to be current smokers or e-cigarette users

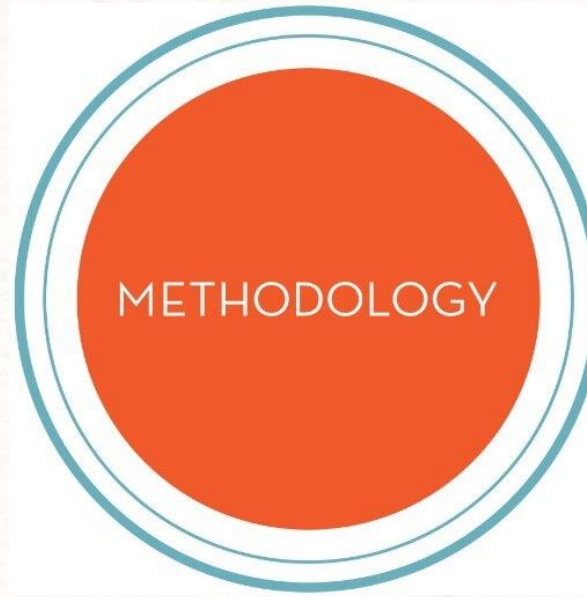

Florida Youth Tobacco Survey (FYTS): 2013 – 2017



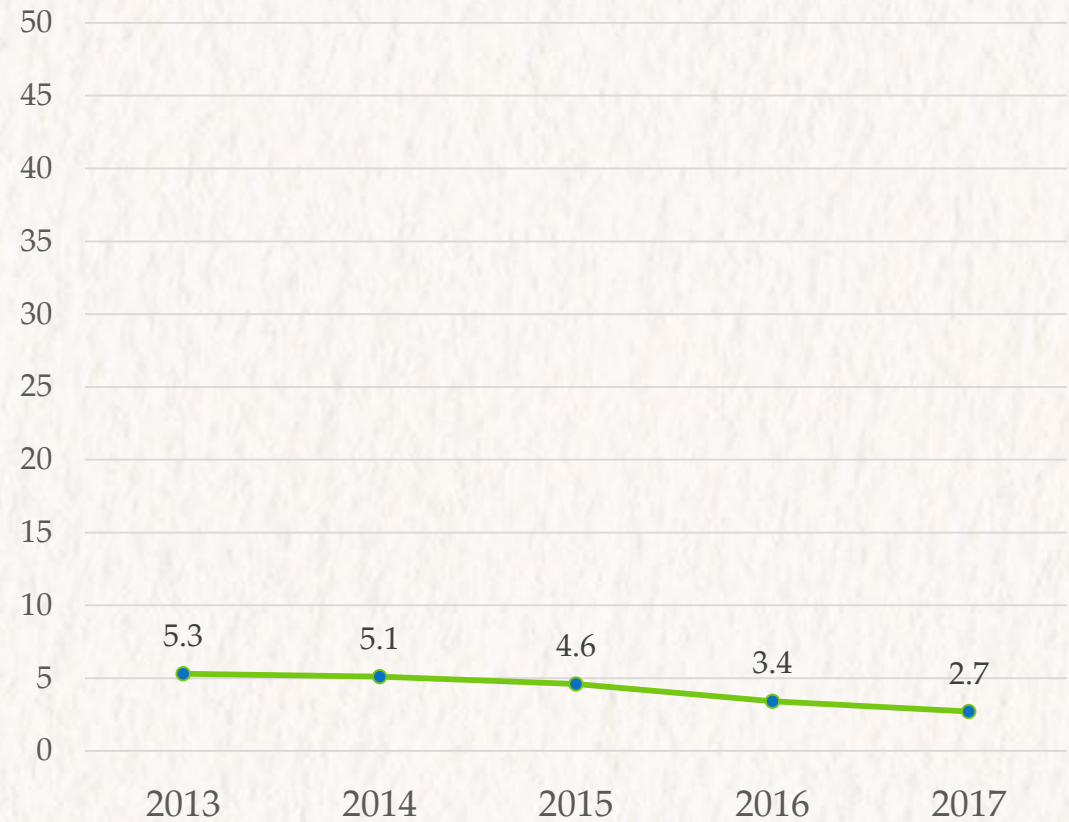
- Survey administration: January-March 2017

2013-2017: % Youth Current Users – Cigarettes



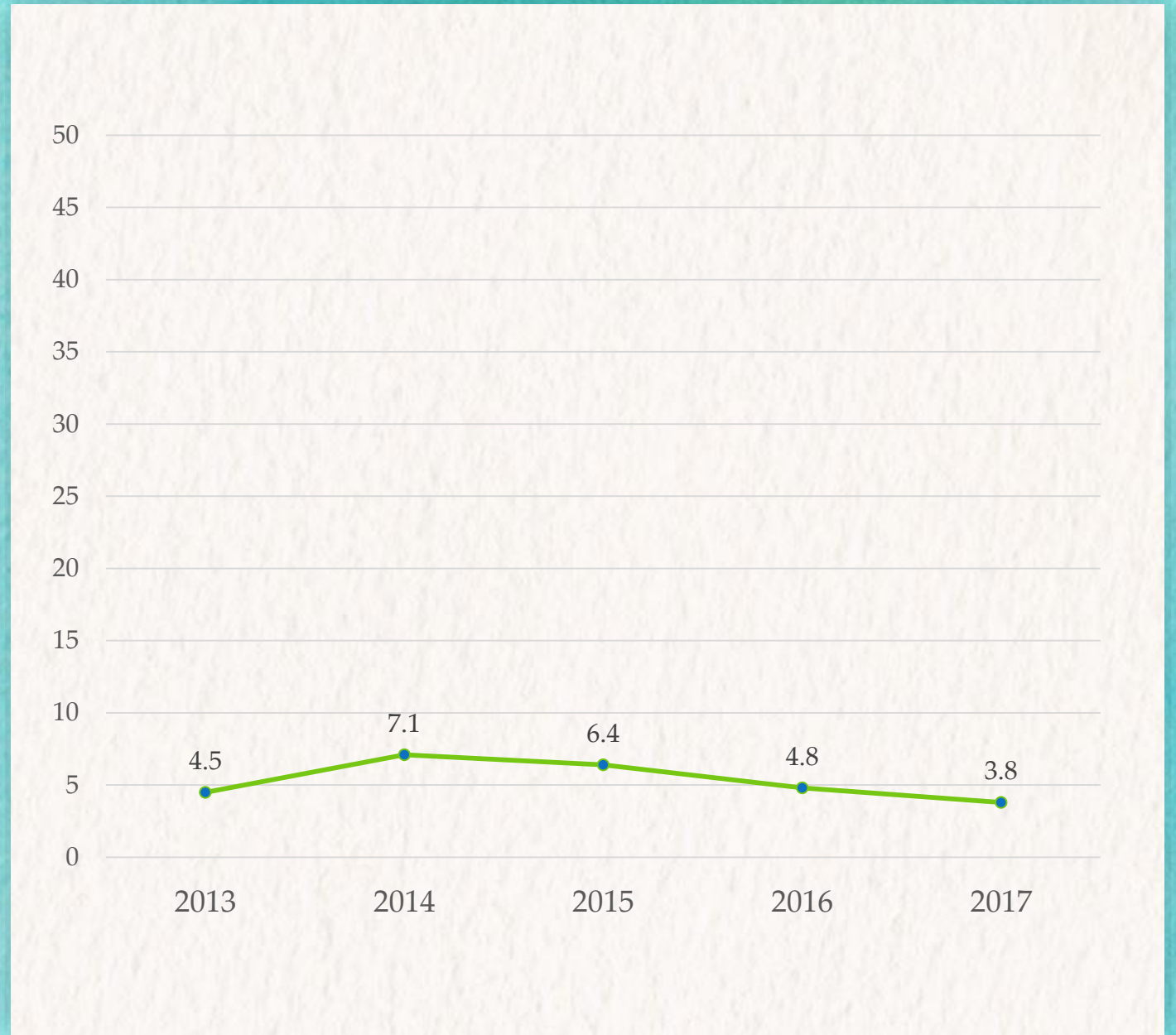
2013-2017: % Youth Current Users – Cigars

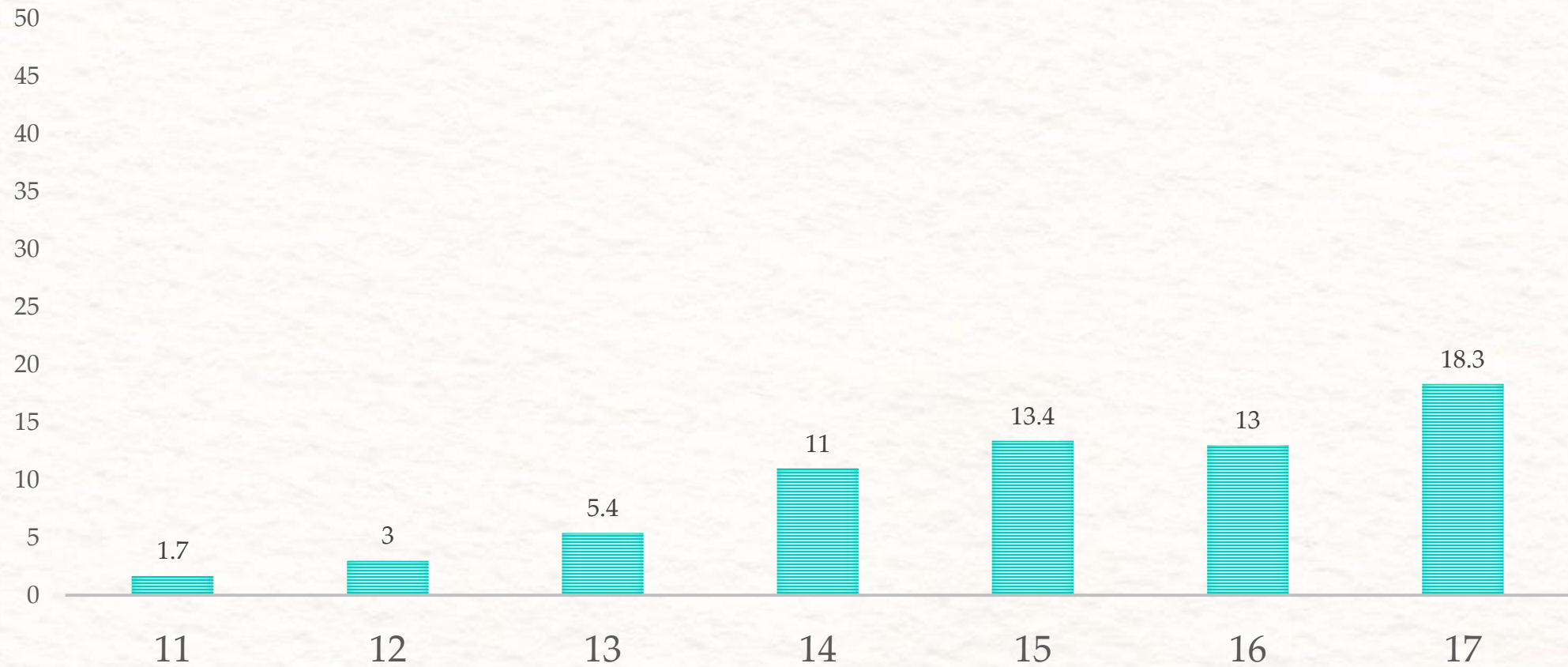
2013-2017: % Youth Current Users - Hookah



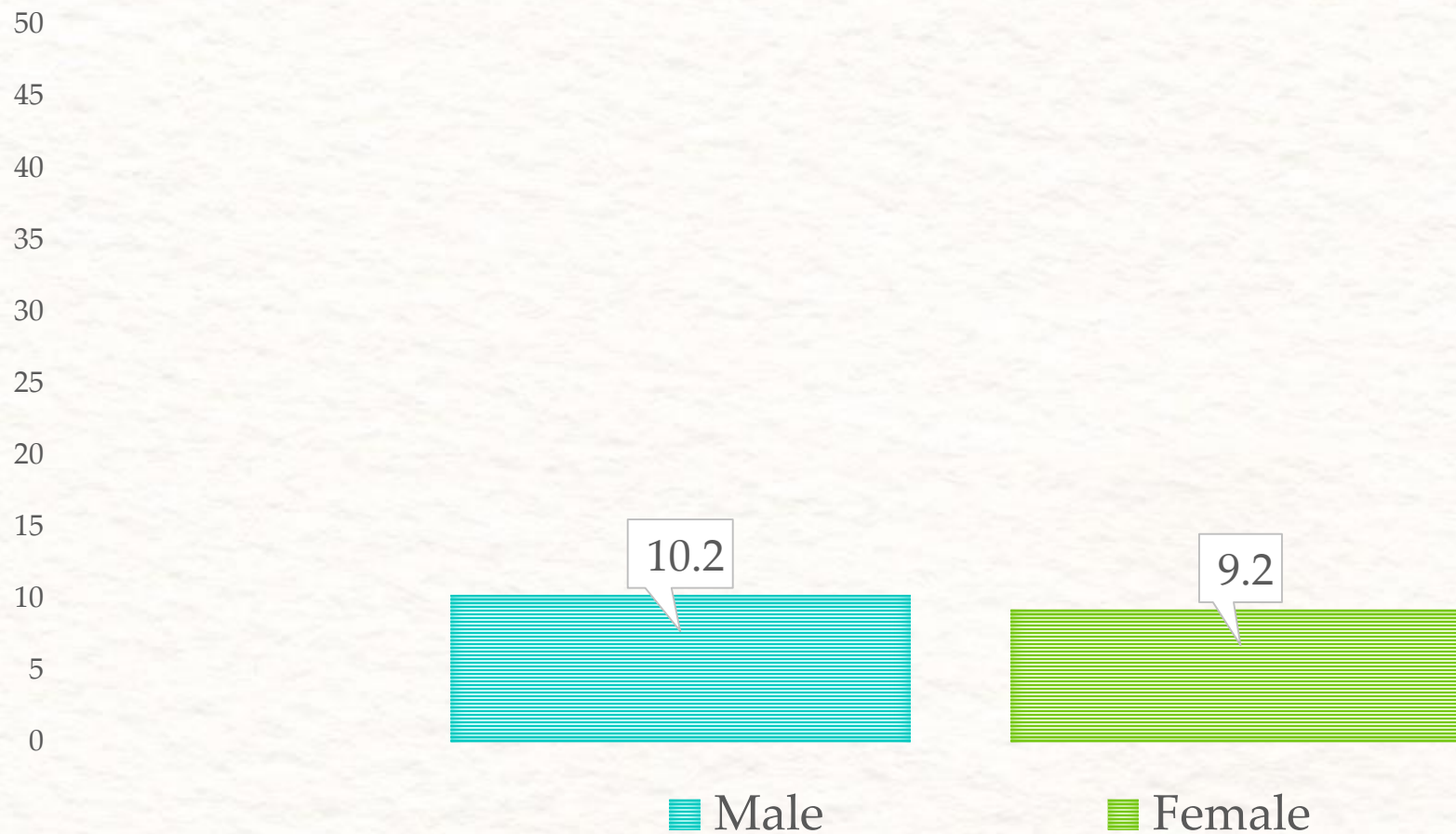

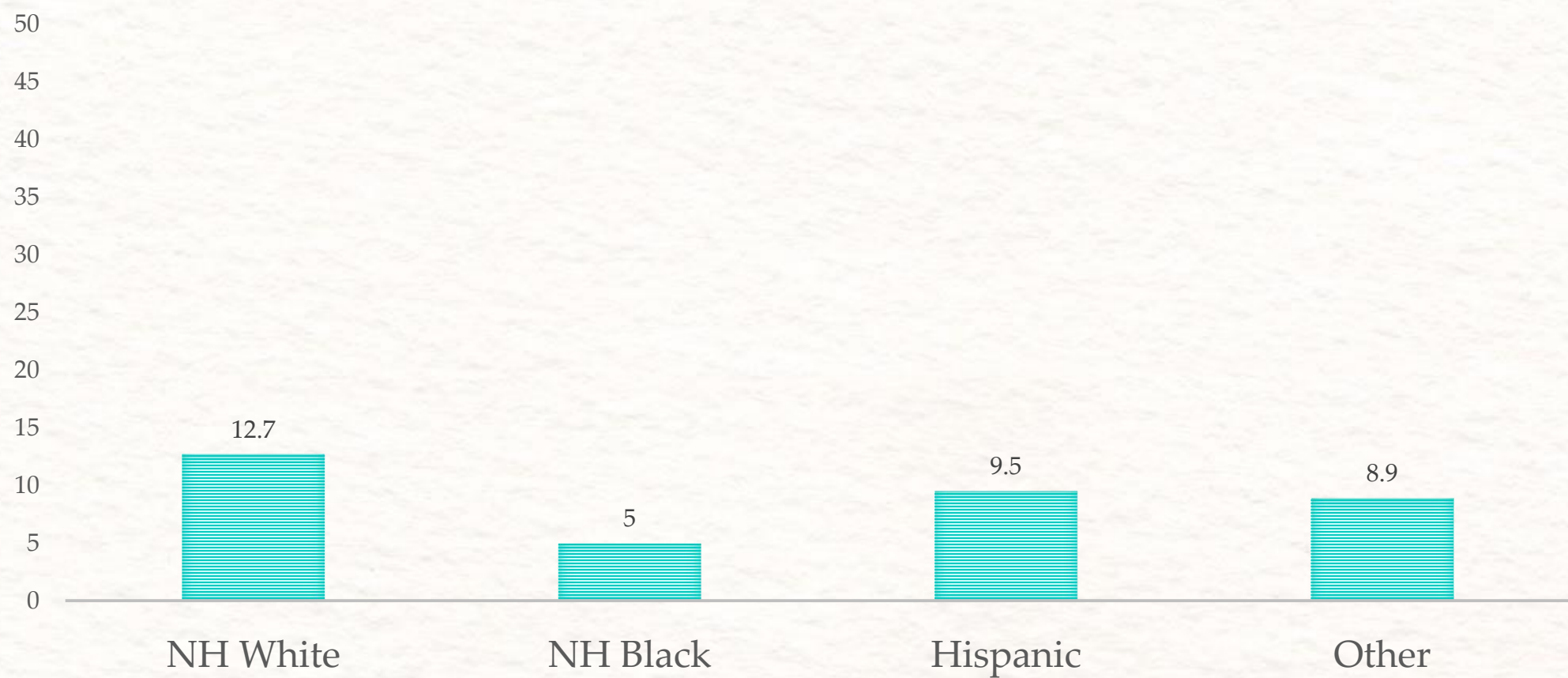
2017: % Youth Current Vape Users by Age

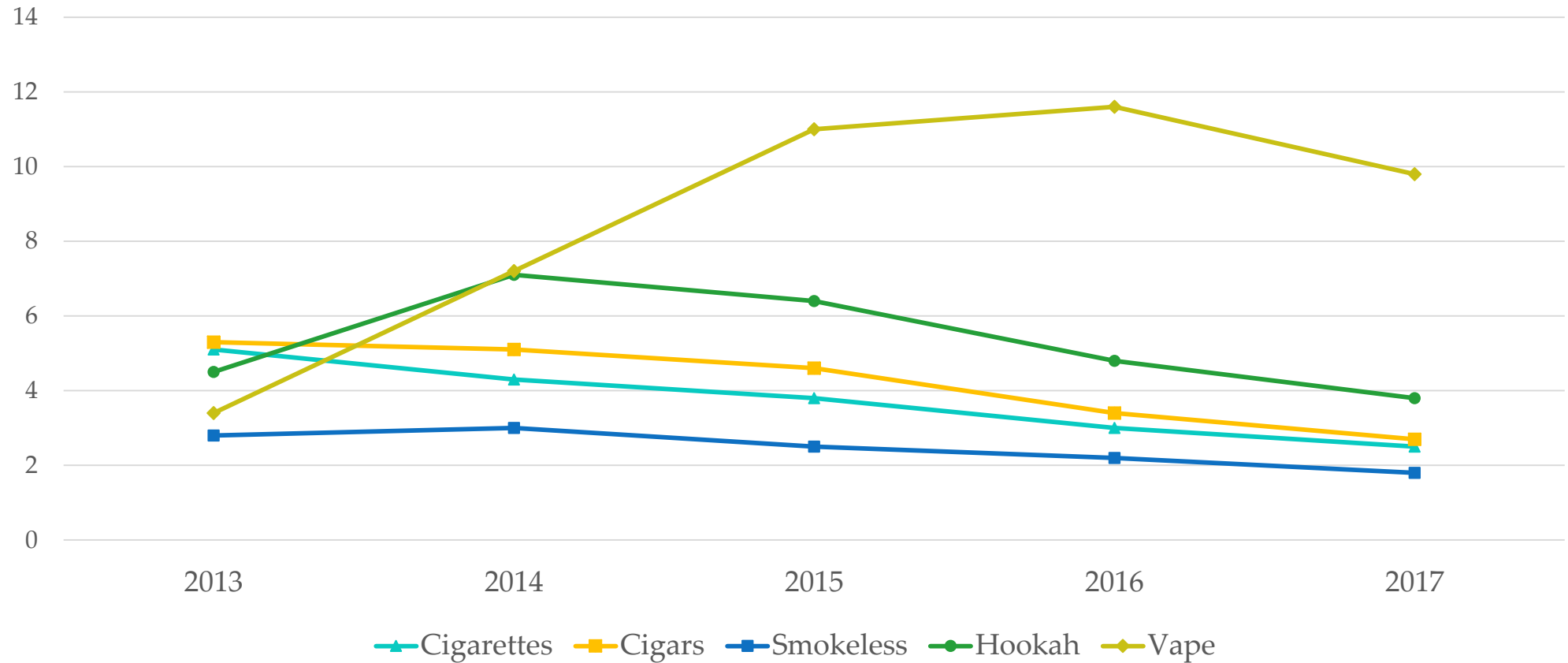
